### **Moreton Bay Delivers Thrilling ProVelo Super League Q Tour Decider**

Moreton Bay has cemented its status as a premier cycling destination, playing host to an electrifying conclusion of the inaugural ProVelo Super League (PSL) season. Over the weekend, Australia's best young cyclists battled it out across the gruelling final three-stages of the Q Tour and historic first season, with Jack Ward and Sophie Marr emerging as the ultimate champions in the PSL Q Tour decider.

The City of Moreton Bay provided a stunning and challenging backdrop for the final leg of the PSL season, with riders taking on the individual time trial at picturesque Lake Samsonvale, the fast-paced road race at Lakeside Raceway, and the brutal Queen's Stage finale in the Moreton Bay Hinterland. Sunday's climactic hilltop finish outside Wamuran proved to be a true test of endurance and strategy, delivering a thrilling spectacle for fans.

With the overall PSL championship on the line, Sunday's Queen's Stage served up a fitting grand finale, as the SumUp Men's League riders tackled 10 laps of the circuit before the decisive 4.7km climb, while the SBS Women's League contenders fought through eight punishing laps before their final ascent. The dramatic hilltop finish saw the strongest and most resilient riders emerge victorious, with the Moreton Bay Hinterland delivering a course that tested every ounce of strength and determination.

City of Moreton Bay Mayor Peter Flannery said hosting the final round of the ProVelo Super League showcased the high standard and challenging location that not only tested competitors, but was a delight for viewers and fans.

"City of Moreton Bay is renowned for its healthy and active lifestyle, which is just one of the reasons it attracts high-calibre sporting competitions like the ProVelo Super League."

As an official event of the Brisbane Cycling Festival, the PSL Q Tour not only showcased elite racing but also highlighted Moreton Bay's status as a world-class cycling hub. Spectators lined the course over the weekend, with many gathering in the event village to enjoy live race coverage on the big screen, local food trucks, and the electric atmosphere.

"We could not have asked for a better setting to crown our inaugural PSL champions," said PSL Co-Founder Matt Wilson. "Moreton Bay provided a course that was equal parts breathtaking and brutal—exactly what was needed to decide the ultimate winners. The atmosphere in the village, the incredible community support, and the stunning roads have all played a huge role in making this finale unforgettable."
